



SLAVERY & HUMAN TRAFFICKING POLICY STATEMENT



This policy applies to all areas and operations of the policy of Maplewood Carpentry Ltd.

Maplewood Carpentry Ltd principal operations are undertaken within the construction industry for various commercial and domestic clients. Maplewood Carpentry Ltd acknowledges the provisions of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within its organization and with supplying and servicing in this industry.

The Company is satisfied from its own due diligence there is no evidence of any act of modern day slavery or human trafficking within its own organization.

As part of the company's due diligence process into slavery and human trafficking as a supplier approval processes incorporates a review of the controls undertaken by the supplier. We do not enrol outside of the UK and EU. The level of management control required for these sources will be continually monitored.

Maplewood Carpentry Ltd will not knowingly support or deal with any business involved in slavery or human trafficking.

Maplewood Carpentry Ltd will undertake responsibility for implementing this Policy Statement and its objectives.

The Policy Statement will be reviewed and published annually.
